Principal's Message:

Workforce Planning for 2025

We are in the final stages of workforce planning for the 2025 academic year. This planning is based on our current enrolment numbers, which may change between now and Day 8 of the new school year. To assist us in making accurate predictions regarding staffing and reduce the need to reorganise classes at the beginning of the year, we've sent parents a survey to update their information.

We appreciate you responding to this survey if:

- You have a 2025 Prep aged student who you have not yet submitted an enrolment for or attended an interview
- Your child is not returning to Norris Road State School in 2025 as you are moving, relocating or your child is attending a • non-government school.

FOR FAMILIES

At present, our enrolment projections for 2025 sit at approximately 570 students. This is a decrease of approximately 30 students from Day 8 2024. This decrease is aligned with broader demographic trends, including the declining birth rate and a drop in population in the 0-14 age group across Metropolitan North. Some of our families will also be relocating to other areas within Brisbane North, regional centres, or overseas.

Term 4 Changes:

We would also like to inform you that Thelma Scammells, our Deputy Principal for Years 3-6, is on leave for the remainder of Term 4 due to health reasons. We expect Thelma to return to NRSS at the beginning of the 2025 academic year.

Strategic Planning:

Last term we shared the affirmations and key improvement strategies from the Executive Summary from our recent school review , highlighting the key affirmations and improvement priorities for the next 4 years. You can find this Executive Summary on our <u>website</u>. The summary highlights affirmations and outlines four key improvement strategies for the future.

Our teachers and teacher aides have been busy participating in workshops to dive deeper into how these affirmations, key findings, and improvement strategies connect. They've also been working on identifying and prioritising the most important areas for improvement over the next four years.

We're also planning opportunities for parents, students, and other stakeholders to get involved. In the second half of this term, we'll be seeking your input to help shape our strategic plan moving forward! Keep an eye out for our parent survey .

Community Garden:

A HUGE thank you to Jodie Mason and family who has funded, organised and established a NRSS Community Garden! Jodie, along with a team of volunteers, engaged in an initial set up last weekend using wicking bed planting systems, and there has already been much interest and wonder from our students about what is being grown and how long it will take!

We look forward to seeing the garden take shape and expanding its scope in 2025.

Voluntary Contribution:


